## SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF CITING/REFEREE'S REPORT/INCIDENT FOOTAGE

The Referee's Report states:

Number 19 Menengai Oilers tackled number 18 Nondies dangerously, he tackled the Player high, the tackle started high and was straight to the head, he was not in a legal tackling position. No action of tackled player could mitigate the actions of 19 green.

## **ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF OTHER EVIDENCE (e.g. medical reports)**

- 1. The Player agreed with the Referee's sending off Report and conceded to the infringement.
- 2. The player's representatives, despite having video evidence of their own, opted not to adduce the video as evidence for consideration.

#### **SUMMARY OF PLAYER'S EVIDENCE**

At the Hearing hereof, in response to the Referee's sending off Report, the Player accepted to have committed an act of Foul Play but added the rider that having watched a video clip of the incident, he, he did not think the tackle was dangeorus.

Upon seeking clarification on whether the player was therefore disputing the red-card, he clarified that he agreed with the referee's fiding and conceded that it warranted the sending-off.

The Player's representative, Dr. Kirori Mindo, affirmed the player's response and confirmed that they were in agreement with the referee's sending off decision.

Despite alluding to the aforesaid video clip, the player and his representative elected not to adduce the same as evidence for consideration during the hearing herein.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

As per the evidence presented which stands urebutted, the player (Oilers 19) executed a high tackle against Nondescript's 18; in the process, he made contact with Nondescript's 18 head.

The player's action, which resulted in direct contact with Nondescript's 18's head, constitutes a dangerous tackle as defined under Rule 9.13. As provided under Rule 17.16.1 (a), the Player has admitted that the act of Foul Play was commmitted. He agreed with the fact that the act warranted sending off. It is therefore my duty to determine what sanction, if any, should be imposed on the Player under Rules 17.17 to 17.21. I am guided by Appendix 1 which provides "Any act of foul play where the person committing the act of foul play makes contact with an opponent's head and/or the neck, and that contact with the head and/or neck warrants a red card, shall result in at least a mid range sanction."

Noting that the victim player did not sustain an injury and was able to continue with play, it is my finding that the act was reckless rather than intentional. A mid-range entry point is therefore warranted.
